Park & game rules



All Buddy League participants must follow the rules listed below and adhere to the instructions of the Buddy League personnel. Thank you for your cooperation.

Player and attendee health

We have many players and attendees with weak or compromised immune systems. Please do not attend Buddy League:

- If you or your child are ill or have been in close contact with someone who is ill
- If you have contracted COVID-19 or have been exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19

Parking

Please be aware of your surroundings while driving in and crossing the parking lot. Park in designated parking spaces. Do not park in the fire lane or areas with striped paint.

Bradfield Ballpark has a limited number of van-accessible parking spaces available. We have players and other attendees who use mobility aids, such as wheelchairs. If you don't require a van-accessible space, please park in another space if you are able to do so.

Inappropriate language & profanity

To keep Buddy League a safe, inclusive, and family-friendly environment, inappropriate or derogatory language of any kind is not allowed. We expect all players, volunteers, and other attendees to keep their language appropriate.

Good sportsmanship

While players in our later games get a bit more competitive, we strive to make Buddy League a fun experience for all participants. Keep it positive and be good sports at the park.

Smoking

Per City of Garland Parks and Recreation, Bradfield Park Ballfields are smoke-free environments. This includes e-cigarettes and any areas at, or within 50 feet of, the park. We appreciate your cooperation as we have players and attendees with sensitive respiratory systems.

Trash

Help keep Bradfield Park and Garland clean and litter-free by throwing away your trash.
